The Society had had another successful year, with a varied and interesting series of talks. These had included: *Berkshire Beyond The Obvious*, *Brickworks in Berkshire*, *The Railway Comes to Maidenhead*, *Wokingham*, *Dipping into the Wells* (about Stoke Row and Highmoor), and *Fires of Windsor Castle*. During the summer, a visit to the *Thames Valley Police Museum* had been enjoyed by members, in the autumn a *Down Memory Lane* at Crazies Hill had yielded much interesting information and the Society had had a most enjoyable *Christmas Party* again. In addition, the Society had held various events as part of the Village Festival - the *Exhibition* had prompted many to recount memories of the village.
